Grace Notes

Next year, 2018, will be International Gospel Church's 90th Birthday. Yes, the church was opened in 1928 and to celebrate we would like to carry out a year long celebration. As an act of thanksgiving throughout the year we could carry out '90 acts of Kindness'. These would be generally small things that would make a difference in the community but there would be a couple of large events as well.

To help with this we are looking for a small number of volunteers to plan and co-ordinate the years activities on behalf of the leadership. If you are interested please contact a member of the leadership team.



Tracking Our Finances

- As you know we have a clear view that as believers we are not subject to the law of tithing. I suspect you've got that clear by now... but equally we know that people do want to partner with us in the grace of giving and that's something we actively encourage. To give you a sense of where we are we've created a simple graph that plots actual income against budgeted income so you can see the extent of any funding gap. As we go to print for the April edition we achieved 73% of our forecast for 16/17 is £797 per week (see table). This was mitigated by higher letting income and cost savings.
- We were delighted to have received gifts in the last few months, totalling £1,050 for our fellowship fund and £600.00 to offset the cost of our recent conference. Thank you so much for these gifts and your general giving. It helps us make a difference.
