## GRACE NOTES ON PURPOSE

### Women Drawn Into the Mystery of Grace

We've got a busy month in prospect; it's Mother's Day today; James and Katy will be dedicating their new baby next Sunday, 13th; we will be having our Gift Day on 20th, and of course we celebrate Easter on 27th. And of course this month sees the start of our new teaching series, "Women drawn into the mystery of Christ". Paul (Anderson-Walsh) the guest on Premier Radio's Woman to Woman show (15th March at 10:30 a.m.) to talk about the series "Women drawn into the mystery of Christ".

Those of you who are new(er) to the church may not be aware that each year we plan a Gift Day. This enables us to defray any shortfall in our income versus expenditure budget.

This year's Gift Day will be on March 20th and we are asking everyone to prayerfully think about what you may be able to contribute. As you know, we are very firm on the principle that "if you're not free not to give, then you not free to give". We have been richly blessed with funds to enable us to look at (finally) putting in disabled access and other capital projects, but we also need to keep a careful eye on our operating budget (our regular outgoings) to ensure we break even each year.

Our forecast operating costs for this financial year is £96k (which includes: staff costs, mission, estate maintenance, office costs, youth/children, PA/IT and our support of Love Burnt Oak, together with other sundry expenses). Our anticipated income/outgoings shortfall was in the region of £11,100. Although our regular income has fallen a bit below what we had hoped for, we have been able to make some savings in our expenditure (Michelle and Viv doing a great job in this regard!), which has reduced our forecast shortfall to £9,000.

A couple of practical points – we will have envelopes available on the day for the Gift Day. If you are a UK tax-payer and are currently on our list (i.e., you either pay by standing order or have a box of yellow envelopes), please simply record your name on the envelope and we will do the rest. If you are a tax-payer but we do not have your details, please record your full address details as well as your name. The Gift Aid scheme enables us to recover a further 25% from the taxman and at absolutely no cost to yourself. So, a £100.00 gift from you is worth £125.00 to the church.
