I thought I'd write a short note this month to keep you updated as to where we are around our money management as we enter into a new financial year for the church.

We are aiming at a break-even budget of £105,800. As you're aware our income, the regular giving, in the church has been trending downward over the last few years.

As an eldership, we want to encourage people who are financially able to partner with us in the ministry of giving and receiving however, we also want to be clear that giving is not a requirement for receiving.

Our commitment to support you isn't related to your ability to support us. The Lord will provide. If He wants to use you as a channel for that then wonderful. Gift Aid forms available. We started the year expecting to be about £200.00 per week behind forecast income, but the first few weeks of the new financial year has seen that gap being narrowed...thank you!

We've sought to balance the books by an increased focus on lettings. We're pleased to tell you that last year's letting income was £42,600 approaching 50% of our budgeted expenditure.


We've got some major projects, totalling around £200,000 that we're aiming to make progress on this financial year. They include:

Disabled access/lower hall circa160,000; Fencing circa £23,000 and a new PA system circa £10,000.
