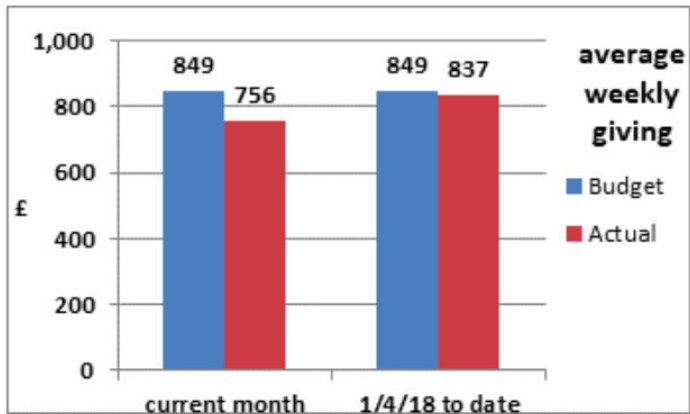


Prayer Meeting

O is for Other-centredness

The signature of spiritual maturity is self-for-others. Paul explains this so eloquently in his exhortation to the church in Philippi. It is the seminal passage on spiritual maturity: Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men." (Phil. 2:3-7)

Sadly, so few, it would seem, attain to it. Why? Because we do consider equality with each other as something to be grasped. Ever since the fall of man we have been reaching out to take each other's place at the top of the perceived power pyramid.

One of the miserable consequences of the Fall is that while we've been freed from it, we haven't attained freedom from it.

As love GROWS we become increasingly less self-centered and more selfless rather than selfish. How does this happen? It's because our new nature operates out of humility, which paradoxically, doesn't mean thinking less of ourselves, but thinking of ourselves less.

Other-centredness is a critical component in our church life model. With love at the centre, informing who we are and what we do, other-centredness is the supernaturally natural way of things.

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:34-35)
