I had originally thought that this month we would begin a short series studying the life and times of Moses but just before going to press I had a check in my spirit - no, not Moses - Joshua.

The opening words of Joshua rang in my head: 2 "Moses my servant is dead. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel. 3 Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given to you, just as I promised to Moses." Joshua 1:2-3

Let's work together to ensure that our legacy is built by grace alone and is not about some of us but is about the sum of us.

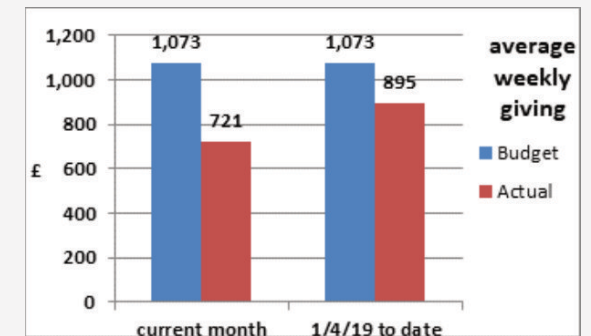
