## Grace Notes: Calling all CLIMATE CHANGERS

Your people will offer themselves freely on the day of your power... Ps 110:3

As many of you will know IGC is a main sponsor of Love Burnt Oak (LBO). LBO's vision of Burnt Oak as a thriving inclusive community that people love resonates strongly with our work in the community and we're now at a point where we need to ask ourselves as IGCers to prayerfully consider how much time we can give to supporting the community work.

Hayley works on a part time basis as the LBO Community Projects' Officer and she's responsible for co-ordinating what are it's current priorities:

1. A digital inclusion programme (which ends this month)
2. The getting-ready for work club (spring/summer 2018)
3. The Real Junk Food Community Kitchen (current/ongoing)
4. The Barnet TV/enterprise initiative (spring/summer 2018)

As you will know if you were with us for the 90th anniversary, on the basis that: Food has the ability to bring people together and to challenge the barriers that divide us. You can never underestimate the power of a great meal - prepared with love and eaten with others.

We are planning to extend the community kitchen work. Last month LBO successfully started both a soup kitchen and the Homework Club.

Each Wednesday we welcome, on average, between 40-80 people into the Cafe downstairs who visit the pop-up pay-as-you-feel supermarket. On their opening day 20 people visited the soup kitchen and eight children (under eight-years of age) attended the Homework Club. We need your help. We're only scratching the surface. We know that these aren't the only needs; there's a need for good pre-loved clothing; pre-loved furniture; beauty boxes and so on and so on and there's a need for these services seven-days a week not just one day a week.


